REVIEW OF ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE COUNTY OF DENBIGHSHIRE

The Local Government Boundary Commission for Wales have today submitted their Final Proposals for the future electoral arrangements for the County of Denbighshire to the Welsh Government.

We propose a change to the arrangement of electoral divisions that will achieve an improvement in the level of electoral parity across the Community of Prestatyn and results in a reduction in the number of Councillors from 10 to 8 elected members.

We propose an overall reduction in the council size from 47 to 42 elected members and a change to the arrangement of electoral divisions that will achieve a significant improvement in the level of electoral parity across the County of Denbighshire. The average number of electors to each councillor for the County is proposed to be 1,798. The proposed electoral arrangements have a level of representation that ranges from 24% below to 23% above the proposed county average

On receipt of the report, the Welsh Government may, if it thinks fit, make an order giving effect to any proposals made to it by the Commission either as submitted or with modifications. Any order giving effect to such proposals shall not be made until after the expiry of six weeks from the day on which the proposals were submitted to the Welsh Government.
